

Fort Worth Metropolitan Police have responded to two theft reports from a local 7-11 store within the past week.

The first robbery took place on Sunday at 3 a.m. and the second robbery was on Thursday at 12:40 a.m., police said. The 7-11 Store is located at 4200 block of Park Springs Boulevard.

Investigators said that they believe the same suspects committed both thefts.

According to the 7-11 clerk, Prakash Patel, two men took packages of cigarettes without paying for them. Both men, who appeared to be in their late 20s, wore dark-colored heavy winter coats and hats, police said.

According to Patel, the suspects drove off in a light blue four-door sedan, possibly a Suzuki. Patel did not get a license number.

Patel said he “screamed for help,” but no one was around. Officers responded within a few minutes of his 911 call.

There were no customers in the store at the time of the robberies. There also have been no reported injuries, police said.

According to police, a surveillance video camera filmed the crimes and footage has been sent to a crime lab for analysis.
